Who we are

Waging Peace is an NGO that supports Sudanese asylum-seekers and refugees to build meaningful lives in the UK. We work solely with the Sudanese community and have expert knowledge of this country, built over more than a decade of dedicated support and collaboration. Since our beginnings in 2004, we have worked to build trust and connections within this community and are delighted to continue this work until today. We provide our services free of charge.

What we can do to help

We aim to help and support our clients holistically, in whatever ways are needed. Data provided will be stored on a secure database according to our privacy policy, unless you let us know otherwise.

Please see below for an overview of some of our main activities, though this is by no means exhaustive:

- Providing emotional support to our clients by listening to any concerns that they may have and giving advice that can help.
- Liaising between clients and lawyers, to aide clear communication and to ensure work is continually being done on asylum cases.
- Providing connections with other members of the Sudanese diaspora to act as a support network, or substantiate aspects of your claim, i.e. membership of a tribal group or political party.
- Referring you to other relevant services that can provide support in other areas such as; finding accommodation, finding employment or accessing healthcare services, providing support with learning English etc.
- Supporting diaspora members to create and run events, particularly training opportunities.
- For clients with whom we have an established relationship, we are sometimes able to listen to their testimony in order to produce a letter in support of their asylum claim. This is not something we routinely supply, however, and should ideally not form the sole reason for your contact with us.
- Providing expertise for asylum claims in areas such as; risks of return to Sudan, risks for different ethnic groups in Sudan as well as numerous other areas.
- Helping clients to source practical items that they need such as clothes or shoes.
- Educating clients on how to contact their MPs. This could be to find out more information from the Home Office on an asylum case, or to lobby them on issues concerning Sudan.
- Producing reports on different issues that occur in Sudan which can be used as evidence in asylum cases. A list is found below.

We are not solicitors and cannot give legal advice, but we can help you to talk with your lawyer, with the wider Sudanese community in the UK, and, where agreed, with third parties that can provide you with further support.

By signing this form you give permission for staff members at Waging Peace to contact you by telephone and/or by email when needed, including to make you aware of opportunities that may generally be helpful or interesting to you, and to pass on such information as is required by third parties in their efforts to provide you with further support where this has been agreed beforehand. You are also giving your consent for us to speak about your case with your lawyer and to have access to the contents of your legal file on your behalf.
