CAN SUDAN AFFORD FIVE MORE YEARS WITH BASHIR?

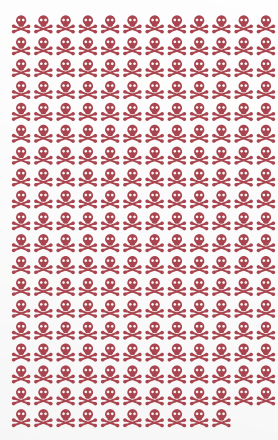
12 JULY 2015 MARKS FIVE YEARS SINCE SUDAN'S PRESIDENT OMAR AL-BASHIR HAD **THREE COUNTS OF GENOCIDE** ADDED TO THE CHARGES OF WHICH HE STANDS ACCUSED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL COURT. HERE IS WHAT HE HAS ACHIEVED IN THE PAST HALF-DECADE, HIGHLIGHTING **THE HUMAN COST OF INTERNATIONAL INACTION** ON SUDAN.



3,402 villages destroyed

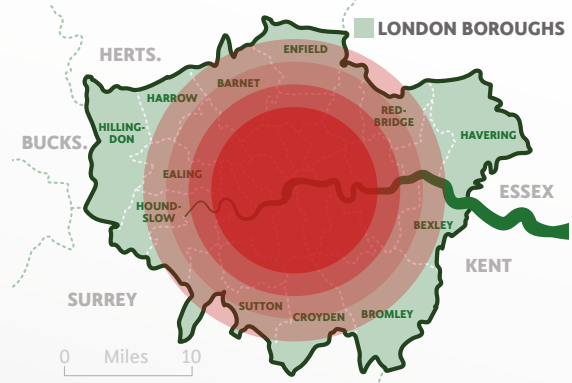
Even using a conservative estimate, the numbers of villages destroyed in Sudan totals 2/3 of those in the UK
